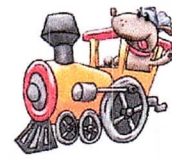

## DOGGIE DEPOT POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration for my dog being permitted to be a client at Doggie Depot for day or overnight boarding, I make the following representations and agree to all of the following policies, procedures, terms and conditions:

- 1. BOARDING REQUIREMENTS.** My dog meets the following requirements he/she: is four (4) months of age or older; is current on his/her Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella vaccinations; is in good general health and free of ticks and fleas; is not aggressive or protective of toys; meets all other municipal or state licensure and other requirements; is attending Doggie Depot with a quick release collar that contains an identification tag bearing the dog's name and guardian or owner's current contact information. I have completed the Doggie Depot Application and my dog will enter and exit the Doggie Depot facility with a leash.
- 2. PROVIDING FOOD.** I understand that my dog will not be fed lunch. If I want my dog to eat lunch, I must bring a container marked with my dog's name and feeding instructions. Owner/Guardian must provide overnight dogs with food, and Doggie Depot will dispense the food in accordance with the instructions provided in the Doggie Depot Application.
- 3. PERSONAL PROPERTY.** I agree that Doggie Depot shall not be responsible or liable for any lost, stolen or damaged personal property belonging either to me or my dog. I also understand and agree that my dog's collar may be removed to prevent injury to any dog. If my dog causes any damage to the Doggie Depot facilities or equipment, I agree to be fully responsible for the full cost of any repair or replacement.
- 4. BOARDING FEES.** I agree to pay for all boarding fees, services and products by cash, check, or credit card at the time I pick up my Camper after each visit to Doggie Depot. I further agree to pay the cost of any check or debit charges returned or challenges for to any reason.
- 5. CANCELLATION POLICY.** I understand that I will be charged for a full day of boarding, if I fail to cancel my boarding reservation at least forty eight (48) hours in advance; or, if my reservation is within three days of a nationally recognized holiday, my reservation must be cancelled within seventy two (72) hours. If I fail to cancel a reservation for a boarding, I understand that I will be charged a no-show fee equal to two (2) nights of boarding.
- 6. REFUNDS.** Doggie Depot's refund policy is available upon request.

7. **AGGRESSIVE DOGS.** My dog is not aggressive. Although Doggie Depot loves all dogs, I understand that aggressive dogs are not permitted to attend Doggie Depot and that if my dog acts aggressively or exhibits unacceptable behavior he/she may be separated from the other dogs. Doggie Depot will use reasonable efforts to consult parents about aggression and ways to address it, however aggressive dogs may be asked not to return to Doggie Depot. Such determinations shall be made at the sole discretion of Doggie Depot.

8. **ABANDONED DOGS.** Doggie Depot is a place where all dogs will be loved, can romp and play. No dog may be abandoned at Doggie Depot. I agree that I will not neglect to pick up my dog by the time he/she is scheduled to leave without providing notification. Any dog that is left at Doggie Depot without any contact, instruction or notification from me, of the ability, willingness or plans to pick him/her up by myself or my personal representative or agent, will be considered abandoned upon the seventh day of such notification failure. I understand that if I abandon my dog at Doggie Depot, we will, by default, become the legal owner and guardian of the dog. Doggie Depot will, in its sole discretion, determine whether to try to rehome and adopt the dog from the Doggie Depot location at which he/she was abandoned or will relinquish the dog to an unrelated shelter of its choice. I FULLY UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT IF I ABANDON MY DOG AT DOGGIE DEPOT, I MAY BE UNABLE TO RETRIEVE POSSESSION OF MY DOG AND WILL HAVE NO RECOURSE AGAINST DOGGIE DEPOT AS PROVIDED FOR BELOW.

9. **DUTY TO DISCLOSE.** I have disclosed and shall continue to disclose on an ongoing basis, any and all medical or other conditions, including but not limited to personality concerns or behaviors that may affect, limit or prevent my dog's ability to attend Doggie Depot.

10. **ACCEPTANCE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK.** I FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT: (a) THERE ARE INHERENT AND POTENTIAL RISKS INVOLVED WITH INTERACTIONS BETWEEN HUMANS AND DOGS WHICH MAY RESULT IN PROPERTY DAMAGE OR BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PERMANENT DISABILITY, SICKNESS OR DEATH TO HUMAN OR DOG; AND (b) THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS NOT KNOWN TO ME NOR READILY FORESEEABLE AT THIS TIME (COLLECTIVELY, "RISKS"). I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL RISKS, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ALL LOSSES, COSTS AND DAMAGES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF MY OR MY DOG'S PARTICIPATION AT DOGGIE DEPOT, INCLUDING ANY VETERINARIAN EXPENSES INCURRED ON BEHALF OF MY DOG. SICKNESS SHALL BE DEFINED TO INCLUDE ANY ILLNESS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BORDETELLA (KENNEL COUGH) OR ANY OTHER FORM OF CONTAGIOUS ILLNESS.

11. **VETERINARIAN LIABILITY AND CARE.** I agree to allow Doggie Depot to obtain medical treatment for my dog, if, in its sole discretion it appears that, he/she is ill, injured or exhibits any other behavior that would reasonably suggest that my dog may need medical treatment. If a dog passes away at Doggie Depot, it will be brought to its or the nearest veterinarian. I AGREE THAT I AM FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF ANY SUCH MEDICAL TREATMENT, AND FOR THE COST OF ANY TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUCH TREATMENT, PROVIDED TO MY DOG.

12. **WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION.** I HEREBY EXPRESSLY AND FOREVER GENERALLY WAIVE, DISCHARGE CLAIMS, INDEMNIFY, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, SAVE, HOLD HARMLESS AND DEFEND AND COVENANT NOT TO USE DOGGIE DEPOT and their invitees, sponsors, advertisers, owners, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, lessors, and any parties owning, controlling or having any interest in the property at which the Event is taking place, and all other representatives or agents (the "Releasees") from and against ANY AND ALL INJURY, LIABILITY, CLAIMS, LITIGATION, ACTIONS, SUITS, COSTS, LOSSES, DAMAGES, EXPENSES OR DEMANDS (including reasonable attorney's fees) OF EVERY CHARACTER WHATSOEVER on account of, arising out of, resulting from or relating in any way to (i) any act or omission of the Releasees, including negligence, and (ii) me or my dog's participation in activities at Doggie Depot, or otherwise. I FURTHER AGREE TO INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees from any claims, litigation, actions, suits, damages, costs, attorney's fees, losses or injuries as the result of any such claim. I AGREE THAT THIS RELEASE SHALL BE BINDING ON ME AND MY SUCCESSORS, HEIRS, LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES AND ASSIGNS. I ALSO EXPRESSLY AND FOREVER RELEASE DOGGIE DEPOT FROM ANY DUTY TO PROTECT ME OR MY DOG(S) FROM INJURY OF ANY KIND, AND AGREE THAT EVEN IF DOGGIE DEPOT CHOOSES TO IMPLEMENT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS, SUCH ACTIONS SHALL NOT ALTER THE FACT THAT I HAVE RELEASED DOGGIE DEPOT FROM ANY DUTY TO PROTECT ME OR MY DOG(S).

## Canine Kennel Cough

---

**We do everything we can...but sometimes canine cough happens!**

As the owners of a kennel, our predominant health concern is canine cough and communicating information about the illness to our pet owners. All of our clients have experienced our strict adherence to our vaccination policies, whether it was on their first visit or when due for an update. We do not allow pups into the facility that are not current on all required vaccinations. These vaccines include Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, and Bordetella vaccine for canine cough. Most veterinarians recommend the Bordetella vaccination if you are going to be boarding your pet. But now that we are able to take our dogs so many places, we have to think of the many opportunities, not just boarding, that our dogs have to encounter the illness. Like the human flu shot, the Bordetella vaccination is not 100% effective. This is because it covers the more common strain of illness that causes canine cough but not all known and unknown strains. Because of this, our pups cannot be 100% protected anytime they encounter other dogs, whether that be for a few moments on a walk, in a pet store, at the park, or even the Vet's office. We know that there is a greater chance for exposure in a boarding kennel environment. However, the more dogs are around other dogs, the stronger their immunity becomes. Their bodies are better equipped to fight illness as their immune system develops and adapts. That does not mean that some dogs are not going to be susceptible no matter what; like our kids, some pups will get every "bug" that comes along. Also, young dogs and older dogs are not going to have as strong an immunity as healthy adult dogs, so we tend to be more cautious with them. Again, just as our kids grow up and develop stronger immunities, our dogs' immune systems also tend to get stronger. Fortunately though, if caught early and addressed, canine cough is usually not serious and runs its course in a week or so just like the common cold. It is still a good idea to contact your vet if you see any symptoms of canine cough. Symptoms can include coughing, sneezing, and possibly a runny nose. It has a signature DEEP CHEST COUGH sometime. Your vet will typically prescribe an antibiotic to minimize the chance of any secondary illness arising and if the cough is severe, a cough suppressant. It is also important to let us know if your dog has had any symptoms. Dogs that have had canine cough need to stay home from our facility for two weeks after symptoms have gone away. \_\_\_\_\_, we do everything we can to keep contagious illness to a minimum. We will always monitor vaccination expirations, ask about your pup's recent health, and take the most conservative approach in dealing with potential issues. Unfortunately, no amount of cleaning and sanitization can stop the transmission of an airborne virus. The opportunity that we feel we have with canine cough is to provide information to our clients so that we can work together to recognize the illness and try to minimize exposure. As always, you should check with your veterinarian to provide information to you about your dog's health. ONE FURTHER NOTE. Many times when boarded in a kennel a dog acts differently that they do at home. They may BARK A LOT. This can result in a sore throat or hoarse sounding bark. THIS IS NOT KENNEL COUGH. IT MAY BE KENNEL BARK but not KENNEL COUGH. We will try to let you know if your dog exhibited this behaviour so you can watch them at home to make sure it goes away fairly quick. A few days and it will usually resolve itself. I \_\_\_\_\_ Have read and understand the Kennel Cough flyer.
